Through the funds raised with your membership dues, other donors, and fundraisers, PIE offers the following grants and programs:

- PIE Grants: \$24,000 is budgeted for educators who apply with innovative and creative ideas for their classroom.
- International Paper Grants: \$2,000 will be distributed to educators during the year for hands-on science and math activities.
- **Beginning Teachers' Store:** \$20,000 has been awarded to PIE through The Harold H. Bate Foundation for class-room materials to award beginning teachers for going above and beyond.
- The Bate Foundation School Grant Program: \$30,000 awarded to schools who demonstrate a need for the following subject area requirements: Art, music, health and fitness, and athletics.
- Chevrolet of New Bern Technology Grant: \$2,500 awarded to a deserving school to assist with the implementation of technology to enhance 21st Century skills in the classroom.
- Wells Fargo Technology Grant: \$3,000 awarded to a deserving school to assist with the implementation of technology to enhance 21st Century skills in the classroom.
- Aspire to Inspire: \$500 awarded in honor of Addison McCoy by Michael and Annie McCoy.
- Twin Rivers Artists Assn. Grants: \$1,000 awarded to four art teachers to assist with project-based needs.
- Stuff the Bus: School supplies are collected each August during Back to School sales. These items were distributed to Craven County students identified by their school counselors and principals as in-need.
- Book Week Drive, November 13-17, 2017: Thousands of books will be collected and distributed to the teachers and media center coordinators for use in the classroom.
