Through the funds raised with your membership dues, other donors, and fundraisers, PIE offers the following grants and programs, for an updated list, and a link to apply, visit www.cravenpartners.com:

- **PIE Grants: \$24,000** is budgeted for educators who apply with innovative and creative ideas for their classroom.
- **International Paper Math & Science Grants: \$2,000** will be distributed to CCS educators for hands-on science and math activities.
- **Beginning Teachers' Store: \$30,000** has been awarded to PIE through The Harold H. Bate Foundation for classroom materials to award beginning teachers for going above and beyond.
- **The Bate Foundation School Grant Program: \$30,000** awarded to schools who demonstrate a need for the following subject area requirements: Art, music, health and fitness, and athletics.
- **Toyota of New Bern Technology Grant: \$3,000** awarded to a deserving school to assist with the implementation of technology to enhance 21st Century skills in the classroom.
- **Superintendent's Exceptional Education Grant for Exceptional Children Grant** - Two grants will be awarded at \$500 each for our ECP classrooms as funded by Superintendent, Dr. Wendy Miller.
- **Aspire to Inspire: \$500** awarded in honor of Addison McCoy by Michael and Annie McCoy.
- **Twin Rivers Artists Assn. Grants: \$2,000** awarded to eight art teachers to assist with project-based needs.
- **Stuff the Bus:** School supplies are collected each August. These items were distributed to Craven County Schools students identified by their school counselors and principals as in-need.
