- **PIE Grants:** PIE awarded **\$38,000** in PIE Grants for innovative and creative ideas for their classroom during the last school year. Your membership directly funds these grants! Every PIE Grant winner receives a ticket to the PIE Annual Luncheon!
- **International Paper Math & Science Grants:** **\$2,000** will be distributed to CCS educators for hands-on science and math activities.
- **Beginning Teachers' Store:** **\$30,000** has been awarded to PIE through The Harold H. Bate Foundation for classroom materials to award beginning teachers for going above and beyond.
- **The Bate Foundation School Grant Program:** **\$30,000** awarded to schools who demonstrate a need for the following subject area requirements: Art, music, health and fitness, and athletics.
- **Toyota of New Bern Technology Grant:** **\$3,000** awarded to assist with the implementation of technology to enhance 21st Century skills in the classroom.
- **Suddenlink Technology Grant:** **\$3,000** available to a school in the areas served by Suddenlink – Vanceboro, Bridgeton, and New Bern schools). Due 12/1, 5:00 pm.
- **Superintendent's Exceptional Education for Exceptional Children Grant:** **Two \$500** will be awarded to middle and high school science teachers as funded by Dr. Wendy Miller.
- **Aspire to Inspire:** **Two \$500 grants** will be awarded in honor of Addison McCoy by Michael and Annie McCoy.
- **Twin Rivers Artists Assn. Grants:** **\$2,000** awarded to eight art teachers to assist with project-based needs.
- **Stuff the Bus:** School supplies are collected each August. These items were distributed to Craven County Schools students identified by their school counselors and principals as in-need.
